

Arte Fiera 2020: a new programme of guided tours in partnership with UBS

Arte Fiera pays special attention to welcoming the general public as well as collectors. **Guided tours**, led by young art historians personally prepared by Simone Menegoi, Artistic Director of the fair, are essential elements of this attention.

The UBS space in Hall 18 will be the meeting point and starting point for the tours. In order to explore the exhibition at the appropriate level of detail, the tours will concentrate either on Hall 18 (devoted specifically to modern art and post-war artists) or on Hall 15 (devoted to contemporary art).

In addition to this daily service, there will be three very special tours, one on each day of the fair (24-26 January): the curators of the special sections (**Francesco Zanot** of the Fantom platform for **Photography and Moving Images**, Laura Cherubini for **Focus**, and Davide Ferri for **Pittura XXI**), will offer visitors in-depth guided tours of their respective sections.
